
# Theory

The KBB is a nomadic community and care project.

KBB focuses on caretaking as an artistic practice and emphasizes the strength this strategy: To call something ART i.e. curating in the sense of creating the frame for something to become ART.

On the other hand, KBB does not curate emergencies, nothing is selected. KBB is completely open. But KBB asks to ask for help and that means that KBB in fact creates problems. KBB forces them to materialize and to be shared. KBB believes that problems, more than anything, have to be shared.

#### **Statistics**

During MPA-B KBB has worked on 29 problems for 127.414 Minutes = 88 Days, 11 Hours and 34 Minutes in the course of 21 Days (!).

25 problems were solved. Each solution took KBB 3 Days, 16 Hours and 29 Minutes on average. The quickest solution took 5 Minutes, the longest one 20 Days, 23 Hours and 34 Minutes.



#### Context

In contrast to other contexts in which KBB performed before, MPA-B is a self-organised and non-funded art event focusing NOT on theatre but on performance art. KBB – NOT theatre itself – is related closely to this area of artistic creation. It appears to be easier for agents in this context to A.... ask for help.

B. ... consider KBB not just a service but an art project.

Thus it was easier for the KBB to respond to emergency calls in a spontaneously artistic, even theatrical, manner. For example, KBB created several video pieces that were presented in a KBB cinema set-up at Meinblau Projektraum.

Nevertheless, KBB supports the decision of the MPA-B organizers to make this one the FINAL and LAST edition of MPA-B. MPA-B has developed from a self-organised local performance art umbrella into an international showcase. It was hilariously successful in making lots of very good art happen

but very unsuccessful in gaining public funding in Germany.

KBB felt reminded strongly of its origin – rendering CARE WORK / SORGE ARBEIT (still mostly operated by FEMALES and paid badly) – visible and label that work ART.






